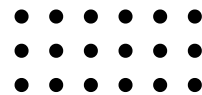

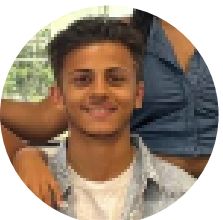
Matthew Marques

6. DRESS CODE

What to wear

- **Dancewear:** Students should wear appropriate dancewear that allows for freedom of movement but also form fitting enough that teachers can see proper alignment. Appropriate dancewear includes leotards, tights, leggings, form fitting joggers, dance shorts or fitted t-shirts. No hats or hoods.
- **Form-fitting attire required (all classes except Hip Hop)** – tanks, t-shirts, tights, leggings, or fitted joggers, sport/athletic zip up are great. No baggy clothing, jeans, sweatshirts, hoodies, or pajama-style looks.
- **Shoes:** Students should wear the required dance shoes for each class, such as ballet shoes, jazz shoes, Salsa shoes, or sneakers. **No Crocs or flip flops.**
- **Hair:** Students should secure their hair in a way that allows them to move freely and maintain focus during class. This can be achieved through various styles, such as a **bun, ponytail, braids, or headbands.**
- **Warm-Up/Layers:** Students are welcome to begin class in layers such as a sweatshirt, long-sleeve shirt, or an extra layer of sweatpants to stay warm. These layers are encouraged to be removed once the body is warm.
- **Boys:** can wear joggers, but please have them be more fitted (not oversized).

ADDITIONAL DRESS CODE NOTES

Dance Bag: Students should carry their dancewear, shoes, and personal belongings in a dedicated dance bag. To avoid confusion, please ensure that your child's name is clearly printed on the bag and all its contents.

Appropriate Use of Dance Shoes: Dance shoes are meant for the dance floor only and should never be worn outside. This helps maintain their condition and ensures a safe and optimal dancing experience for all students.

We appreciate your support in upholding these dress code policies, as they contribute to a focused and disciplined learning environment. Should you have any questions, please feel free to reach out.

SHOES

Proper shoes should be worn by the end of October. Wearing the proper shoes during class will ensure them to be "worn in" by our 1st show, Christmas. Each class/style will require specific footwear.

~ Salsa & Bachata

Girls must have Latin heels in the tan or nude color. They come in various heel heights. The best place we found to get them is on Amazon. Foot sizing is provided on the site. We will provide links in our WhapApp class chats in September.



Boys must wear Latin "ballroom" or "cuban heel" dance shoes in the color black. Amazon is a great resource. Foot sizing is provided on the site. We will provide links in our WhapApp class chats in September.

~ Hip Hop

Any sneakers will work during class. If a specific color for any of our shows is required, we will let you know in advance via email and/or the WhatsApp class chat.

~ Praise

For these classes, there are options. Dancing bare feet, a jazz shoe or in a sock-like shoe works for these classes. It's really up to the dancer's comfortability. If the dancer would rather wear a shoe, there are a few style options but the color must be a nude (your skin tone). Amazon is a great resource. Foot sizing is provided on the site. We will provide links in our WhapApp class chats in September.



~ Ballet

A basic ballet slipper is required. They can be purchased at any department store or online. During class, any color is acceptable. However, for the shows, the slippers must be pink as a part of the show costume.



~ Musical Theatre/Jazz

A jazz shoe is required for all students. For kids' classes, please wear black jazz shoes. Teens should wear tan or nude jazz shoes.



~ Homeschool Theatre

This class does not have a clothing requirement other than...be comfortable!

7. FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

REGISTRATION:

We do have an annual non-refundable registration fee per family.

For each family, **the fee is \$35.**

TUITION:

Tuition is paid on a monthly basis. Payments are due on the 1st of every new month.

They can be made via cash or credit card. Automatic payments are also an option. Please request this option before your next payment is due. Overdue tuition will accrue a late fee of \$10 on any payment that is made after the 15th of the month.

- **One (1) Class/Style per week:** \$58 per month
- **Two (2) Classes/Styles per week:** \$106 per month
- **Three (3) Classes/Styles per week:** \$149 per month
- **Four (4) Classes/Styles per week:** \$187 per month
- **Five (5) Classes (UNLIMITED)/ Styles per week:** \$220 per month

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES:

Tuition does not include dancewear, shoes, costumes, showcase tickets, private lessons, or special events.

JUNE 2027 SHOWCASE COSTUMES:

Showcase Costumes will be chosen by the instructor to ensure it fits the theme of the dance. We will require a deposit. The balance can be made in installments until the final due date. Measurements will be taken in January/February during classes. **Tentative Costume cost is typically \$85-\$100 per costume.** More details can be found in our 2027 Showcase Handbook, which will be distributed later in the season.

REFUNDS:

Refunds will not be issued for missed classes due to student absence, public holiday or studio closure (ie: weather). Where possible, we will do our best to arrange make-up classes cancelled by Art In Motion Dance & Fitness or will offer an alternative class. We appreciate your adherence to our tuition and payment policies. Should you have any questions or need further clarification, please don't hesitate to contact us. We are here to assist you and ensure a smooth and convenient payment experience throughout the dance season.

8. GENERAL POLICIES & RULES

ATTENDANCE:

As we know sometimes absences are not avoidable, however, regular attendance is essential for students to progress in their dance education. Each class builds upon previous lessons and missing a class may leave a student lagging behind their peers. For both our Christmas and Annual Showcases, choreography will be taught and rehearsed. It is necessary for students to feel confident with the choreography and their performances. Frequent absences during class can lead to frustration for both your child and their classmates which will affect your child's confidence and overall performance.

Please contact us via phone, email or class chat if your child will miss a class. If your child misses 3 or more classes in a row, we require a private lesson, at your expense, for your child to get caught up.

DISCIPLINE POLICY:

At AIM, we strive to maintain a positive, professional environment. Students are taught the value of being part of a group and are encouraged to respect their peers, teachers, staff, and studio property. We emphasize the development of good habits and compliance with rules of conduct. Our staff and faculty employ constructive discipline techniques to ensure class control and address individual misbehavior:

- Children who exhibit unacceptable behavior or attitudes are informed and guided toward positive alternatives.
- In cases of physical contact between children, the individuals involved are respectfully separated and asked to explain the situation. They are encouraged to find a solution, communicate with each other, and reconcile.
- Disruptive children are politely requested to cease their behavior. If the disruption persists, they are reminded of its impact on others. If the behavior continues, the children involved will be asked to sit down for a brief period (usually three to five minutes) before rejoining the class.
- If a child's misbehavior consistently disrupts the class, the caregiver or guardian will be contacted to pick up the child

DOS AND DON'TS:

- Avoid speaking negatively about other studios staff, teachers, students or families.
- All students are expected to show respect for teachers, staff and other students at all times.
- Inappropriate behavior and language may result in dismissal from Art In Motion.
- Caregivers should refrain from comparing their child's progress or class placement to that of another child. It is important to watch for such behavior in your children as well and encourage them to focus on their own achievements.
- While seeking inspiration from other students is beneficial, speaking negatively about your child's teachers, fellow students, or other caregivers in their presence—or in front of other students—can lead to problems beyond the initial concerns. Children often imitate their caregivers' behavior when interacting with other adults or authority figures.
- Caregivers and students should not interrupt any class in session. We appreciate the chance to meet our students' siblings, but the safety of every child at the studio is our top priority.
- If your child has a break in between classes, we can not be responsible for your child during that time. Due to limited space within our studio, we kindly ask that you take your child outside of the studio. Feel free to use this time as their snack or lunch break before returning to the studio. Outside of class times, children must always supervised and should not run around any area of the studio and/or classroom areas.
- No food, gum or candy during class! However, water breaks are allowed. Please be sure to have your child bring their own water to class.
- Use the restroom before or after class. Students may leave class only for emergencies after informing the instructor.
- Art In Motion Dance & Fitness management reserves the right to change instructors or schedule when necessary at any time throughout the year. We do have instructor substitutes if needed.

CLASS VISITORS:

- To maintain safety and uphold our legal responsibilities, we are unable to allow students to bring visitors into the classroom on a regular basis. Students should refrain from inviting siblings, other relatives, or friends to their classes, with the exception of special events such as "Bring a Friend Week", etc. and in-school performances.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:

- We kindly request that students arrive at least 5 minutes before their scheduled class time. For the safety of children under the age of 10, we require that they be promptly picked up immediately after their class. Students ages 10 and older should be picked up no later than 15 minutes after the completion of their class.
- We do know that you are excited to watch your child during class, however, space is limited and we do not want our students to be distracted. For this reason, parents are not permitted to stay in the studio during classes (except the MINI CLASSES you are welcome to watch in case your child needs your assistance). For everyone else, we ask you wait in the car or drop them off and return by the end of their last class.
- We are unable to take responsibility for our students before or after their scheduled classes and it is the responsibility of the parent to ensure their child is picked up and dropped off on time. In the case of an emergency or unavoidable delay, please contact the studio immediately to inform us of the situation so we can keep your child calm and safe until they can be picked up.

LOST & FOUND:

- Please ensure that all dance bags, dancewear, shoes, and personal items are clearly marked with your child's name. We will make every effort to locate and return lost items; however, we cannot be held responsible for any items brought to class by your child.
- ***This includes electronics, toys and stuffed animals.*** Please refrain from bringing them into the studio to potentially be lost or distracting to other students.

ILLNESS:

Children are susceptible to contagious diseases, such as colds and flu, which can easily spread among classmates. To protect your child's health and minimize the risk of contagion at the studio, **please keep your child at home if they exhibit any of the following symptoms:**

- Green or yellow nasal discharge
- Complaints of ear pain
- Persistent cough
- Severe sore throat
- Pink, burning, itching, or discharging eyes
- Diarrhea or vomiting
- Fever

If your child displays these symptoms or any other contagious conditions during a class, we will contact you to pick them up immediately. When your child has a fever, please keep them at home until their temperature returns to normal. If there are any lingering signs of illness, such as cough, glassy or watery eyes, lethargic behavior, or drowsiness, please keep your child at home to ensure their full recovery before resuming class activities the following week.

ANY QUESTIONS...COME TO US

- Students and caregivers are prohibited from contacting teachers directly (via phone, email, text messages, etc.). All communication with teachers or the director must go through the AIM office (admin/front desk staff). To ensure effective communication, please avoid approaching your child's teacher or the director between or during classes, as well as making contact outside of the school, including through social media, DMs, personal emails, and similar channels. All communication should be directed through the Art In Motion office via email at info@danceataim.com or by phone at 856-245-7170. This ensures that we can maintain a professional and organized approach to addressing any concerns or inquiries.
- If you do request a meeting, it is important to attentively listen to what your child's teachers have to say. They spend a significant amount of time with your child and possess expertise in the field of dance education.

TERMINATION OF ENROLLMENT:

In certain circumstances, it may be necessary for the director to terminate a student's enrollment in the best interest of the student(s) involved. Every effort will be made to address and resolve any issues before resorting to termination. Reasons for termination of enrollment may include:

- Disruptive or dangerous behavior exhibited by students or their caregivers
- Abuse of other children, staff, or property
- Inability of AIM to meet the child's needs

We prioritize maintaining a safe and conducive learning environment for all students, and termination of enrollment is only considered when it is deemed necessary and appropriate.

CLASS WITHDRAW:

Withdrawal from classes must be done through our AIM withdrawal form, which can be obtained from the front desk or via email. *It is important to note that all costume and tuition/registration fees are non-refundable. Once the withdrawal form is received, tuition payments will cease.

We appreciate your cooperation in following this procedure to ensure a smooth transition for both the student and the studio.

9. SAFETY & PRIVACY

Safety First...



With the safety of our families as a number one priority, Art In Motion Dance & Fitness is very serious about upholding Child Protection Laws and Policies within the studio.

As part of your registration, you will have read and signed a media waiver allowing us to proudly use images and video footage of your student for advertising and promotional purposes. Should you have any concerns whatsoever with signing this declaration, please see our reception staff who will happily assist you.

The owners and staff at Art In Motion Dance & Fitness are educated in the negative impact of inappropriate music and costume selection when it comes to performing dance routines. We are wholeheartedly committed to ensuring that children in all of our dance routines are not subjected to any inappropriate music or costuming. We recognize that songs with sexist, explicit, violent, racist, homophobic or criminal content may influence our dancers and/or audience. We will strive to avoid playing such music.

You will find within our Youth Dance Program Registration Form a public liability / insurance statement. Please read this document carefully and sign it prior to your child's first class with us.

HEALTH & WELLNESS PRIVACY:

To ensure the safety and well-being of all students, it is crucial for caregivers to inform the director and/or teachers if their child uses an inhaler or requires medication while attending classes at AIM. Additionally, we kindly request that you communicate any existing medical conditions or learning differences your child may have at the time of registration and throughout the school year. This information is vital for our teachers to provide the best possible support and create an inclusive dance experience for all students.

Please be assured that all medical information shared with us is treated with the utmost confidentiality. We respect your privacy and understand the importance of maintaining sensitive personal information in a secure and professional manner.

Our teachers are eager to work with children of all abilities and personalities. By sharing relevant information, you enable us to tailor our teaching approach, provide appropriate accommodations if necessary, and ensure the well-being of your child during their time at AIM.

We keep to ourselves...

PRIVACY:

When you purchase or hire a product or service with Art In Motion Dance & Fitness the information we may collect from you includes your name, address, telephone numbers, email addresses, medical information and perhaps credit card or bank details. It may also include details of the products and services we provide to you as well as the status of your enrollment.

We only collect information directly from our students or their parent/guardians primarily for the purpose of providing services and products to you and to administer and manage invoicing and debt collection.

We may occasionally use your information to promote and market to you information which we consider may be of interest to you unless you contact us and tell us not to do so.

We will never sell or pass on any of your information to third parties unless required by government authorities or in the event of debt recovery. Any information passed on will be done so with appropriate privacy and confidentiality protection.

Information is stored securely in paper or electronic form and is accessible only by authorized personnel.

We appreciate your cooperation and trust. Together, we can create a safe and supportive environment that allows every student to thrive and fully enjoy their dance education.

WINTER SHOWCASE / Saturday, December 19th 2026 *tentative

Our Winter Showcase is a more “laid-back” version of our June Showcase, with shorter routines, no costume fees, and lots of holiday cheer!! It’s a great way for our new students to experience what our Showcases are like. We choose a specific theme for each class, and ask parents to choose their own costumes that match the theme. This allows each family to decide how much they want to spend, and gives the dancers freedom of expression and individuality!
